2017 Cancellation Policy

I understand that unanticipated events happen occasionally in everyone's life. In my desire to be effective and fair to all clients, the following policies are honored:

Advance Notice of Cancelation

A 24 hour advance notice is required when cancelling an appointment. This allows the opportunity for someone else to schedule an appointment. If you are unable to give us 24 hours advance notice you will be charged the full amount of your appointment. This amount must be paid prior to your next scheduled appointment.

No-show

Anyone who either forgets or consciously chooses to forgo his or her appointment for whatever reason will be considered a "no-show." They will be charged for their "missed" appointment. You may, however, send someone else in your place.

Late Arrival

If you arrive late, your session may be shortened in order to accommodate others whose appointments follow yours. Depending upon how late you arrive, your facilitator will then determine if there is enough time remaining to start a session. Regardless of the length of the session actually given, you will be responsible for the "full" session. Out of respect and consideration to your facilitator and other customers, please plan accordingly and be on time.
